The product has to be labelled due to the calculation procedure of the "General Classification guideline for preparations of the EU" in the latest valid version.

The petroleum naphtha / petroleum distillate / lubricating oil meet the requirements for not being classified as carcinogenic (<0.1% benzene alt<3% (w/w) DMSO extract (IP 346)).
